## Pols Push to Derail LICH Building Sell-Off

A group of politicians last week asked DASNY to step in and halt any sell-off of Cobble Hill brownstones and other properties owned by the Long Island College Hospital. The politicians—Assembly members Joan Millman and Hakeem Jeffries and state Sens. Velmanette Montgomery and Daniel Squadron—suggested in a letter that DASNY “object to the pending sale and related activities until a more global approach to LICH’s future is decided. Therefore, we respectfully request that you carefully consider taking steps to persuade CHP to terminate the selling efforts.” LICH’s parent, Continuum Health Partners, recently put the properties up for sale. LICH’s medical staff opposes the sale plan and enlisted the aid of local lawmakers in their effort.
